

8,000 crates, 4,200 man-hours to move Emerson from Austin

Emerson Process Management recently moved to the Frontera Vista complex in Round Rock, replacing its location in Austin.

The new facility will serve as the company's international headquarters and technology center for Emerson Process Management's systems and solutions division, the *Austin Business Journal* reported on Tuesday.

EDC Moving Systems in Austin was the company that handled the move. Salesman and Project Manager [Ted Ulmer](#) said it was one of the biggest commercial moves in recent years.



He provided some interesting numbers:

- About 800 employees were moved into 250,000 square feet, requiring the relocation of 3,500 computers and more than 10,000 devices.
- Emerson employees packed more than 8,000 move crates and used about 25,000 labels.
- EDC provided about 4,200 labor hours, utilizing a crew of 44 movers and six trucks.
- It rained during the move, so EDC obtained a 60-foot awning to protect equipment from the truck to the building.
- Ulmer said that only one device was damaged during the move and it required a repair that cost \$100 to fix.
